Pioneer Camp 2 will begin Wednesday with registration at 3 PM. The closing worship service will be Friday at 4 PM. Parents are invited to closing worship as well as supper at 5 PM that evening.

EXPLORER CAMP is for students who have completed grades 3-5. This is an exciting age group to work with. They are full of energy, enthusiasm and curiosity! And at this age, many of them are ready to be away from mom and dad for a full 5 days! So if this sounds like your son or daughter, this is the week for them.

ADVENTURE CAMP is for those students who have completed grades 6-8. Young people in this age group are searching to find identity. No greater joy can be found once they discover their identity in God as their Heavenly Father. They are sons and daughters of the King!
