Summer Head Cook - 2022

Job Description: This person directs the kitchen including and not limited to ordering food, planning menus, preparing food, kitchen cleaning and overseeing staff and volunteers that may help with food prep.

Requirements:

- Our Head Cook is a person who works well with others, plans ahead, is disciplined in spending and makes good food.
- Minimum age: 18 years
- Be a member in good standing of a congregation of a Christian Church and adhere to Statement of Faith and bylaws of the Camp.

Compensation:

- \$2500/summer
- Room and board
- An incredible place to work and a ton of fun

Job Duties:

- Perform all the duties pertaining to the kitchen in consultation with the Director
- Prepare and serve high quality nutritious meals and snacks in a spirit of high hospitality.
- Order food according to projected number of participants for a summer and budget
- Prepare all food items as directed in a sanitary and timely manner
- Label foods with known allergens prior to meals
- Follow recipes and presentation specifications
- Rotate food stock and throw away left-over food as needed to maintain healthy food supplies.
- Operate standard kitchen equipment safety and efficiently
- Clean and maintain station in practicing good safety and sanitation
- Be responsible for the cleanliness of the kitchen and dining area, including food storage area, refrigerators, and freezers.
- Adhere to all sanitation and food production codes
- Create schedules for all of your direct reports (cooks and volunteers)
- Report all needed repairs in kitchen to the Director.

We are excited to offer another year of summer programming, and we are looking for a Christ-centered staff that is committed to the Lord's service for Summer 2022. If you would like more information about what it looks like to work at camp, call us with any questions you may have.

Enclosed is a summer staff application form for you to complete and return to us via email or mail. In order to be considered for the position of head cook, the applicant must be at least 18 years old by the summer of 2022.

Please fill out the application accurately and honestly and return it to us when it is complete. Be sure to list three references, as well as their contact information, before returning the application. Your three references should be individuals that would be able to give a complete evaluation of who you are. (Some good references would be a Pastor, Youth Director, past employer, an adult friend of the family, etc.)

Please have your application completed and turned in by March 20th. We certainly will take applications after this date, but in order to be sure that we consider you for employment it is important to get the application in as soon as possible. It is our goal to finish interviews by the end of March, and you will hear from us by mid-April in regard to the selection process.

Summer staff will arrive for staff training on Sunday, June 5, by 1:00 PM. Room and board are included while you are on the camp site. The cabin leader schedule is 6.5 weeks of camp (June 15-July 29) plus 1.5 weeks of training (June 5-June 14). The last day of work will be **Saturday, July 30**.

Be sure to indicate any special skills or interests you have that are helpful for us as we consider your application. Please join us in praying for God's wisdom throughout this process. Thank you for your interest, and we look forward to hearing from you!

New Hope is located 3 miles south of Platte, SD. The camp sits on 40 acres of beautiful pasture. The Edgerton Creek winds its way through the east side of the property. We are just 11 miles from the mighty Missouri River. New Hope exists as a living testament to the redeeming power of God in Christ Jesus. We seek to proclaim the name of Jesus as we live a life of love and servanthood to children, youth and families.

The Traditional Camp Experience: Campers stay in cabins with 1 counselor and 1 assistant counselor. They participate in many things offered on the camp site. This includes chapel, Bible studies, big group games, quiet time, free time, outdoor and indoor recreational activities, meals together, campfire, and a lot more. We may also go into Platte to enjoy the city pool and aquatic center there.



What can I look forward to as a summer staff member?



Our desire is that summer staff would first and foremost walk away from the summer knowing more of our Heavenly Father's heart, our Savior's life, and the Spirit's power. WE WANT YOU TO KNOW MORE ABOUT THE LOVE OF CHRIST! That is our number one goal. Our number two goal is that summer staff would be better equipped and able to share the love and heart of God with others. It is our greatest desire for you not only to minister to others during the summer, but that you also come to know Christ in a deeper way in your personal life as well!

What do we do each week? Each role at camp is different, but rewarding.

Counselors have responsibilities including helping with program events such as chapel, Bible studies, campfire, skits, swim time and all-camp activities. You will be in a cabin of 8-10 youth with an assistant counselor. Counselors are also responsible for teaching and at times disciplining youth.



Assistant Counselors are expected to be good role models by being appropriate in all things, at all times, and following ALL camp rules. Assistant Counselors help and encourage the Counselor in all the duties they have with their cabin group. You carry the same duties as the Counselor, but they bear the responsibility.



Support Staff are fully involved with the life and ministry of New Hope, interacting with the campers as they assist in planning and leading program elements, such as all-camp activities and craft time and lending a hand in the kitchen when needed. They also supervise during swim time, so anyone with Lifeguard experience is welcome, though not required. All staff are expected to stay at camp and be involved in the lives of the campers and the programming each evening.
